Airdrie-Bathgate Rail Link Project

The cycle path between Airdrie and Bathgate, part of the National Cycle Network Route 75, is to be relocated as part of a £300 million project to re-open the Airdrie-Bathgate railway line.

The existing path will close on **19 October 2008** and more than **£7.3 million** will be invested to construct a new path as close to the original route as possible - the new path will open in **December 2010**.

Network Rail recognises the importance of the route to cyclists and the local communities it serves and apologises for any inconvenience caused during its relocation.
