

### **SMARTER CHOICES SMARTER PLACES LONDON ROAD CYCLE FACILITIES**

**(city centre) (traffic management)  
(amendment no.3) order 2010**

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of a traffic regulation order introducing cycle facilities and amendment to existing waiting and loading restrictions at various locations along London Road, James Morrison Street and St Andrews Street.

It is proposed to issue Penalty Charge Notices in accordance with the provisions of the Order and the proposed costs are as follows:- £60 or £30 if paid within 14 days or £90 if unpaid after 56 days.
