Thank you for your e-mail of 12 January and the opportunity to comment on this proposal.

GoBike! supports this Order. We are pleased to see that you propose to control parking on streets in Cranstonhill improving the free movement of wheeled vehicles. The purpose of roads is to allow the passage of traffic, rather than the storage of motor vehicles. Controlling parking by resident permits etc and enforcing these controls improves the environment not only for car users but particularly for pedestrians who are able to walk on footways clear of parked vehicles. It also makes it far easier for pedestrians to cross the road by ensuring that junctions and clear of parked vehicles and thus improving visibility.
