# Engagement



Glasgow City Council is holding an online consultation and walk-in session with design workshop to assess how we can improve walking and cycling in Woodside.

We are proposing a number of changes to improve the environment for cyclists, pedestrians, local residents and businesses.

New designs could see the implementation of:

- ◆ New public space and paths
- ◆ Pedestrian and cycle zebra crossings
- ◆ Reallocation of road space
- ◆ Segregated cycle lanes

This is to increase road safety, improve public space, increase the number of cyclists, and reduce sustainable transport journey times.
