THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (MEIKLEWOOD ROAD) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 201_

The Council propose to consider the introduction of the above named traffic regulation order and my purpose in writing to you is to undertake preliminary consultations to confirm the technical feasibility of the scheme in advance of publication of any proposals in accordance with statutory requirements and procedures.

The reason for this proposal is to introduce loading and waiting restrictions at junctions and cycle lanes along Meiklewood Road. This will allow safer access and egress from junctions as well as enable full use of the cycling facilities leading to and from the new Glasgow South Hospital.

I enclose a copy of the detailed plans of the proposals which will introduce the following:

New No Waiting No Loading At Any Time;

Along the south kerbline of Meiklewood Road

Should you consider your working practices to be adversely affected by these proposals, I would be pleased to hear from you within **14 days**. If I have not heard from you by that date, I shall assume that you have no objection to the Council proceeding to publicly advertise these proposals. In the meantime, should you require any further information or clarification on any points arising from the proposals, do not hesitate to contact my assistant Michael Gallardo at the number below.

Should the Council proceed to advertise a traffic management scheme for the area following this preliminary consultation exercise a copy of the notice of the proposed Order will be forwarded to you intimating a final opportunity to lodge any objections to the proposals.
