## The Glasgow City Council (Maryhill Road/Napiershall Street) (Junction Improvement) Order 201.

Thank you for your prompt response to our concerns. We withdraw our objection to the increase in parking and are thus in general approval of your proposals.

However, we would point out that we suspect that some of the transport may attempt to stay for more than 10 minutes in the short-stay parking. Could you please ensure that the Parking Wardens are alerted to the changes and that staff at the Community Central Halls are also aware of the parking restrictions and direct drivers to the appropriate car park?

We are pleased that Advance Stop Lines and pedestrian crossings are to be installed under these proposals.
