Glasgow City Council is holding an online consultation and walk-in session to assess how we can improve walking and cycling on Jura Street.

We are investigating a number of possible options to improve the environment for cyclists, pedestrians and local residents.

New designs could see the implementation of:

- ◆ Improved paths
- ◆ Improved pedestrian crossings
- ◆ Reallocation of road space
- ◆ Cycle lanes

This is to, improve public space, increase the number of cyclists, improve road safety and reduce sustainable transport journey times.
