Data Protection

We are currently undertaking internal preparation work towards the next LDP, as outlined in our [Development Plan Scheme](#). Our intention is to carry out full engagement with all stakeholders later in 2018, ahead of publishing a Main issues Report. Details of this will be provided through the LDP Newsletter, alongside wider publicity, once arrangements have been finalised.

As you may be aware, the [planning system in Scotland is currently being reviewed](#), and this may have implications on the preparation of our next LDP. We will update our Development Plan Scheme accordingly as soon as possible after the outcomes of the review are known.



Draft Air Quality Planning Guidance

Draft Air Quality Planning Guidance has been produced and interested parties are being invited to have their say.

The draft document provides further information and detail on policies set out in the East Dunbartonshire Local Development Plan. In particular, the draft guidance sets out detailed criteria that will be used by the Planning Authority to determine the need for an Air Quality Assessment. The approved guidance will form part of the LDP and will be used to determine planning applications.

The consultation period begins on 28 May, closing on 25 June 2018.
