

THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (Scottish Exhibition and Conference Centre) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2009 (Amendment No.1) Report

Glasgow City Council, in conjunction with the Scottish Event Campus, propose to make changes to the existing roads layout to improve the safety and welfare of all visitors.

The proposals include restricting access into the Campus at certain times, and, as part of these proposals, works will be carried out on Congress Road. A roundabout will be formed at the west end of Congress Road, with a new carriageway built to the north of the existing carriageway. The purpose being the implementation of hostile vehicle mitigation measures in the wake of events in Manchester in 2017.

A new bus stop will be formed on the existing carriageway, to hold two buses, and a taxi stance on the new carriageway, with space to hold eighteen taxis.

A disabled "drop-off" zone will also be formed at the west end of the new carriageway.

The existing "No Waiting No Loading" restrictions will be maintained.
