

Heathcot Avenue (Traffic Regulation) order 201_

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Council have been made aware of road safety issues with the existing two-way traffic flow on Heathcot Avenue. This order is being proposed in line with the Councils Local Transport Strategy and would improve road and pedestrian safety by introducing measures that would remove potential driving conflicts, prohibit vehicles parking at obstructive or inconsiderate locations and increase visibility at pedestrian crossing points.

The list of roads affected by these proposals are: Cairnsmore Road, Drumry Road East, Heathcot Avenue, Heathcot Place

Details of the proposals are as follows:

1. No waiting at any time restrictions
2. One way operation
