B759 Cathkin Road (30mph Speed Limit) Order 201_

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Council have been made aware of potential road safety issues with the existing 40mph speed limit on the B759 Cathkin Road. This is due to a new housing development being built on this section of road which will increase the volume of local traffic. The Council are looking to improve road safety by reducing the speed of vehicles travelling on the B759 Cathkin Road, which will make access and egress safer for vehicles accessing the new Coulters Brae housing development.

The list of roads affected by these proposals are: B759 Cathkin Road.

Details of the proposals are as follows:

Implementation of a new 30mph speed limit on an existing 40mph section.
