**THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL,
(Laurieston Phase 2) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 20__**

Thank you for your email of 10 May and the opportunity to comment on the proposal to introduce a 20mph mandatory speed limit to protect the Laurieston Phase 2 development.

Given that in this and all your proposals for a reduction from 30 to 20mph there is the reasoning that lives will be saved with the speed reduction we are very concerned that:

1. you do not introduce a mandatory default speed limit of 20mph across the city, with any increases above that having to be fully justified
2. you do not manage and enforce the existing 20mph mandatory speed limit zones across the city.

That said, and since we wish to have all the protection possible for people who walk and cycle in this city, we offer our support for this proposal.
