Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The proposal will introduce a 20mph speed limit on Byres Road, Church Street, Torness Street and Highburgh Road to improve road safety and bring speed limits into line with surrounding residential areas.

AREA AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED ORDER

The roads affected by these proposals are generally bounded by: Great Western Road to the north, Hyndland Street to the west and Dumbarton Road to the south.
