Thank you for your email of 06 January and the opportunity to comment on this proposal.

GoBike fully supports the proposals to reduce the speed limit on Byres Road to 20mph. This is a residential and commercial area, which has a lot of activities happening during the whole day. The reduced speed to 20mph will reduce the severe injuries and fatalities if collisions occur between drivers (motor vehicles) and cyclists/pedestrians, it will reduce the likelihood of collisions happening and it will improve the air and sound quality of the street in line with the placemaking aims of the Byres Road Public Realm Project. This reduction is also in line with the City Council's plans to make all urban roads 20mph.

With a speed limit of 20mph Byres Road will be a safer road for all users and this TRO has our full support.
