TORYGLEN GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE

The £3.3 million pound investment project will transform circa 16 hectares of land into a mixed-use park and play areas, wetland, nature reserve, woodland and sustainable transport routes. The project will further enhance Malls Mire Community Woodland by improving accessibility and providing new facilities for outdoor learning and natural play.

The park will cater for both local and wider communities by providing a desirable, healthy location for outdoor recreation, volunteering, travel, education and relaxation.

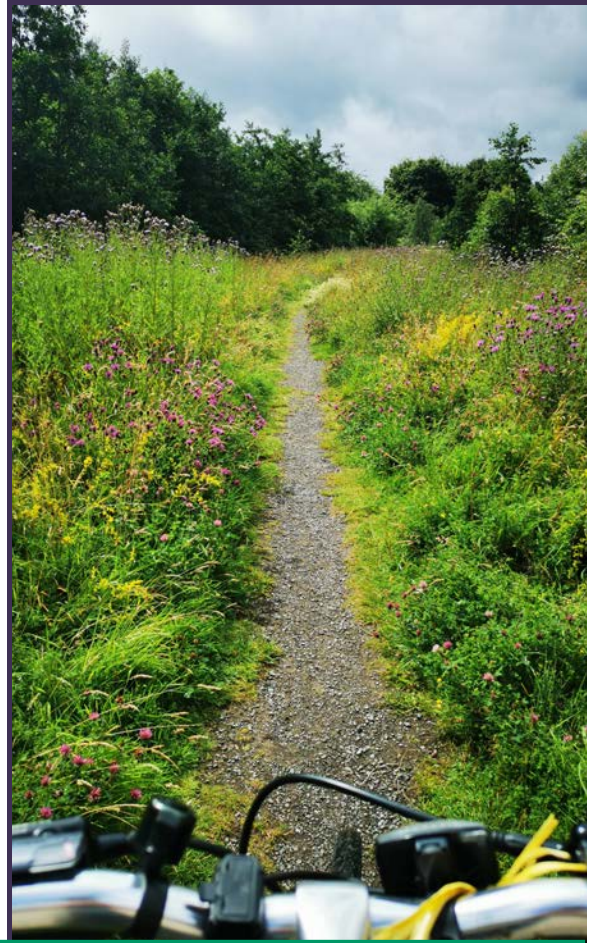
